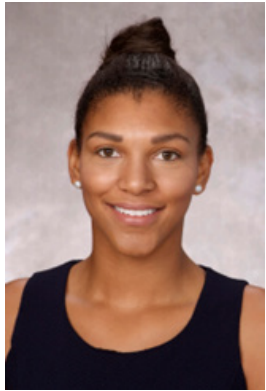




MICA MEDICAL FOUNDATION SELECTED SCHOLARS



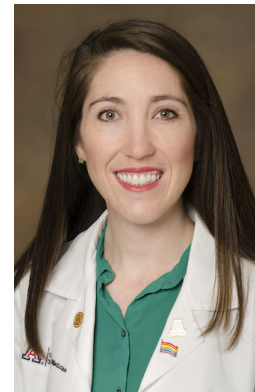
