- Relief and prevention of pain during and following surgical, obstetric, therapeutic and diagnostic procedures.
- Performance of nerve blocks, management of PCA devices, and placement of epidural injections or other such techniques performed for surgical anesthesia or pain control during the surgery/procedure or in the immediate post-operative period.
- Monitoring and maintenance of normal physiology during the perioperative or periprocedural period.
- Direct resuscitation in cardiac and respiratory emergencies, including the need for artificial ventilation.
- Supervise post-anesthesia recovery.
- Management of critically ill patients.

 - Percutaneous or Endoscopic Disc Decompression
