



MICA Risk Management Tip of the Month

Surgeons may be asked by patients at postoperative visits if the surgeon can refill the patient's thyroid, cholesterol, etc. medications, since the patient cannot drive for a certain period of time postoperatively. Risk wise, refill only medication applicable to the condition you are treating the patient for and redirect the patient to their PCP to obtain a refill for their monthly medications. If possible, your office could contact the PCP on the patient's behalf that the patient needs a refill for medication prescribed by the PCP.
